I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

Pursuant to notice, a regular meeting of the Sedona Fire District (SFD) Public Safety Personnel Retirement System (PSPRS) Local Board was called to order by Chairman Dave Soto at 2:20 p.m. on, Thursday, September 22, 2022. The meeting was delayed due to technical difficulties logging into Zoom, etc. Executive Assistant Kim Smathers recorded the minutes. A quorum was present, and the meeting, having been duly convened, proceeded with business.

II. EXECUTIVE SESSION

A. Possible vote to go into Executive Session for legal advice on discussion of preliminary investigation matters pertaining to retirees pursuant to ARS §38-431.033(A)(3).

Chairman Soto made a motion to go into Executive Session. Board member Craig Cushenberry asked if the old minutes did not have to be approved before executive session began, as there was a motion from the last meeting regarding hiring a local Board attorney.
