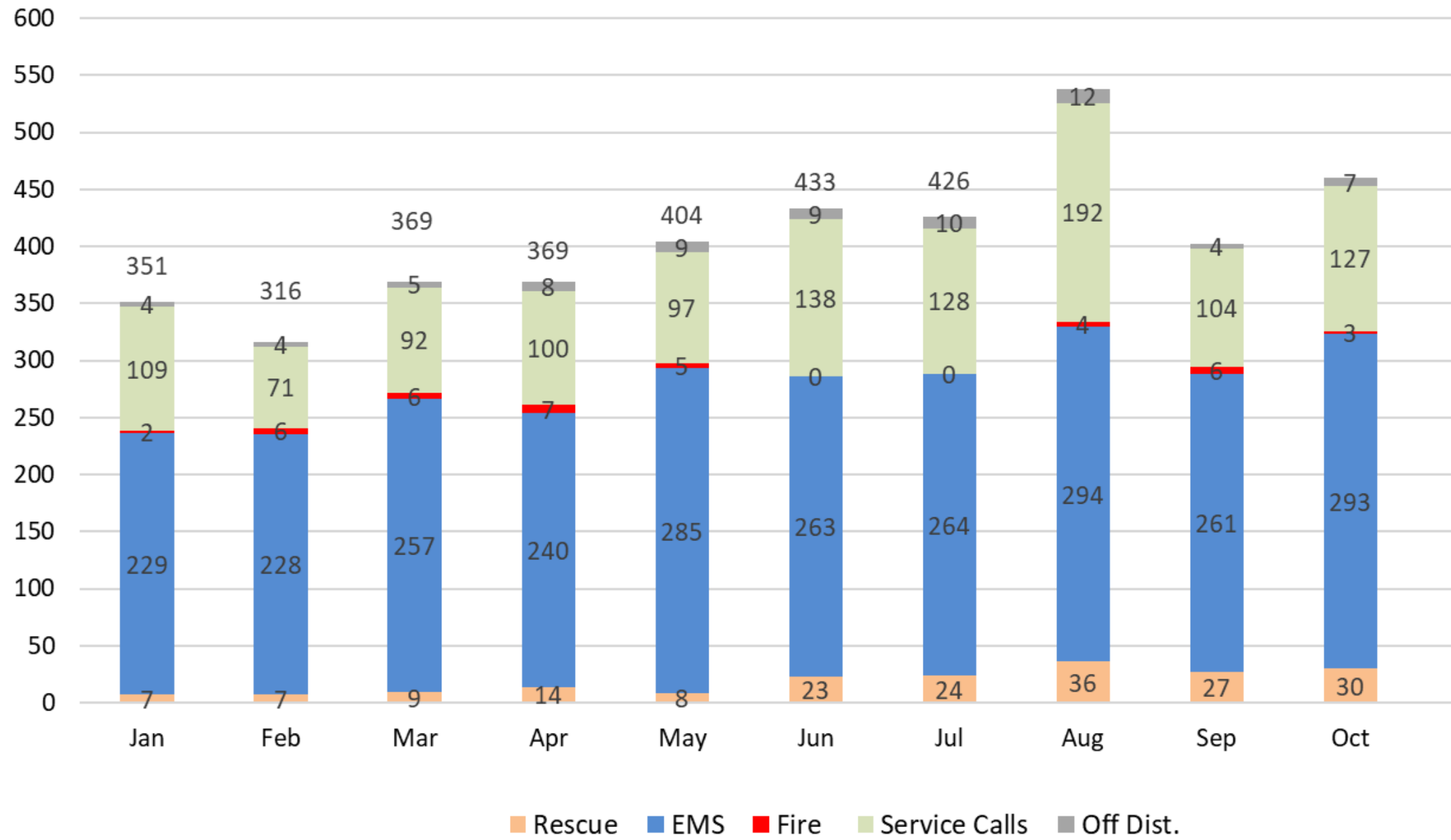

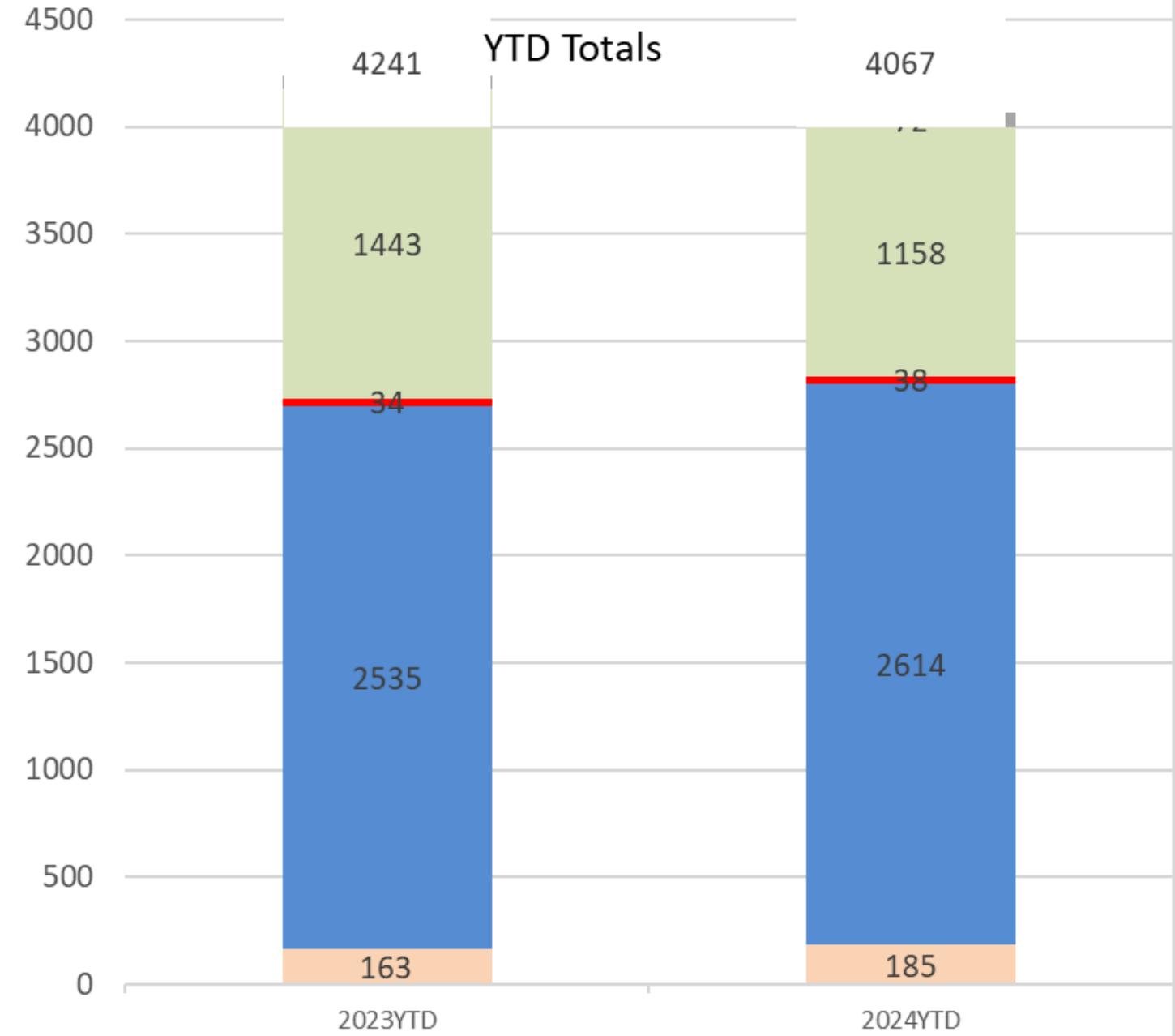

2024 Monthly Incident Summary

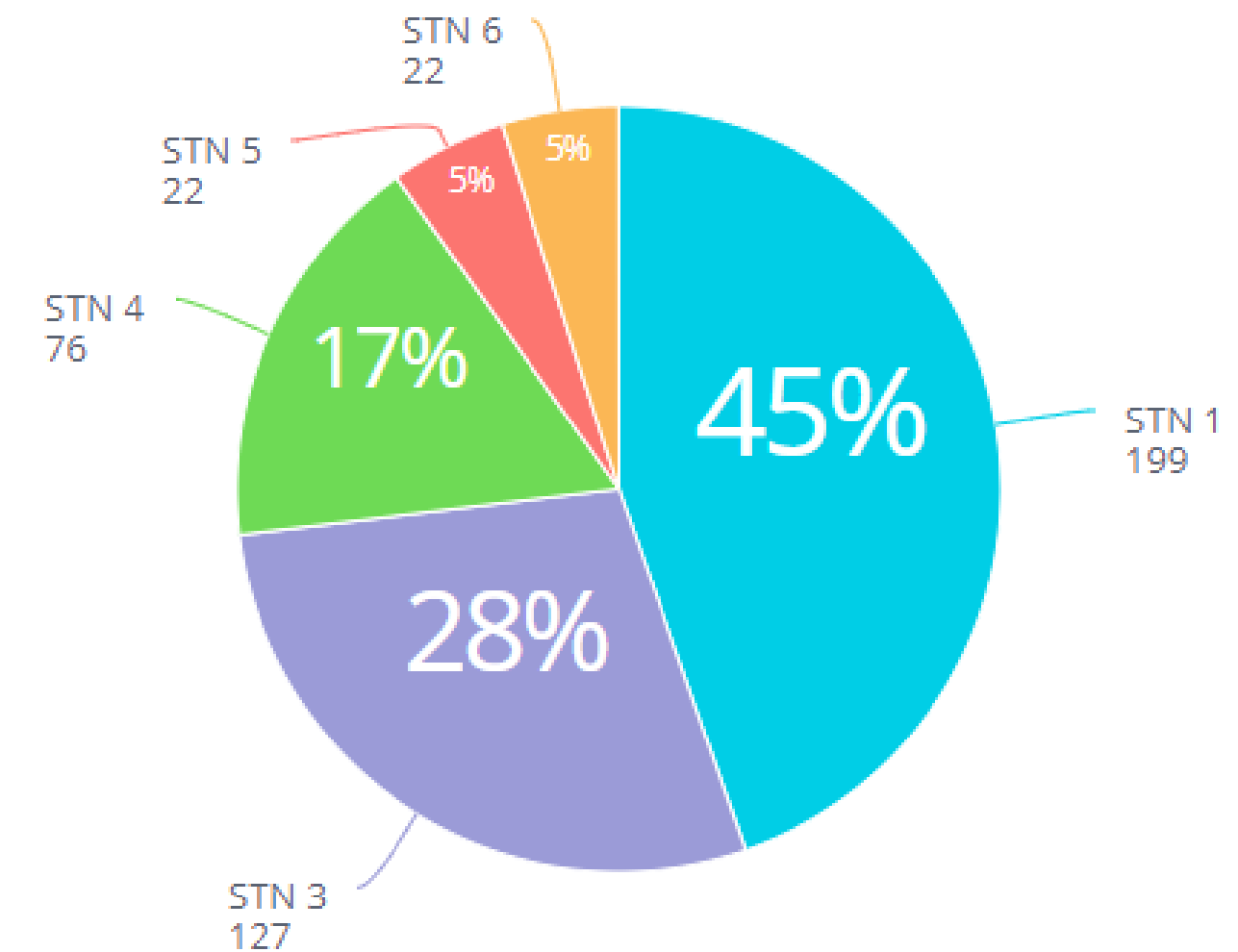
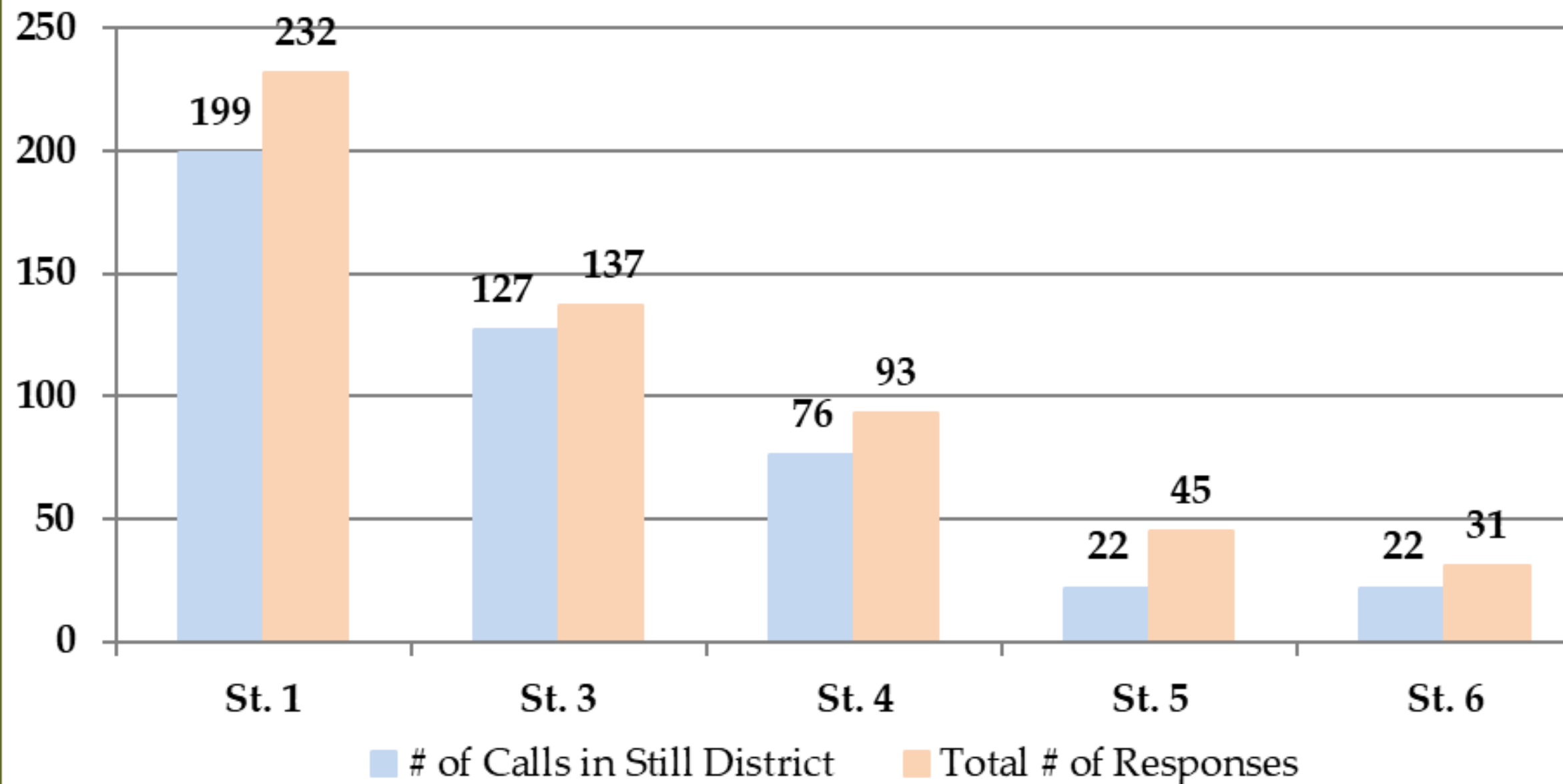


YTD Totals
